

MEETING MINUTES
REPUBLICAN LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 11
MAY 2, 2006

On May 2, 2006, Chairman Haney called the Republican Legislative District 11 meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Arizona-American Italian Club, 7509 N. 12th Street, Phoenix, AZ.

The invocation was given by Rev Wes Darby. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by Jeff Greenspan.

Chairman Haney introduced guests, candidates and elected officials.

Jeff Greenspan discussed the two Stop Taxing Our Property initiatives and asked for volunteers to collect signatures. The initiatives are: C-08-2006, Redefining Residential Property Tax Valuation in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX Section 18, and C-09-2006, Reinforcing Residential Property Tax Limits in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX Sections 18 and 19.

Randy Pullen spoke on his Protect Our Phoenix City Initiative. Mr. Pullen distributed petitions

to PC's to help collect signatures.

Senator Leff spoke on SN-1157 which Governor Napolitano vetoed This bill would have, made it a state crime for aliens to cross the border into Arizona. Representative Allen spoke on the alien situation. Representative Tully spoke on the proposed state budget.

John Rutledge, First Vice-Chairman, Arizona Republican Party, talked about the reinstated Trunk & Tusk program. 'The theme for the 2006-2007 series of dinners is Presidential Candidates. Counties and districts can raise money by selling T&T memberships. The first dinner will be held May 20, with Governor Mitt Romney of Massachusetts.

A quorum was present at the May meeting and the April 11th meeting minutes were approved as corrected. Treasurer's Report is posted on the website.

Chairman Haney introduced guest speaker Sea Dean Martin, Republican candidate for State Treasurer. Senator Martin spoke on his accomplishments in the state legislature and the duties of the Treasurer's office.
