**MEETING MINUTES**  
**REPUBLICAN LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 11**  
**JULY 11, 2006**

On July 11, 2006, Chairman Haney called the Republican Legislative District 11 meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Arizona-American Italian Club, 7509 N. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Phoenix, AZ.

The invocation was given by Sen. Barbara Leff. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by The Honorable Tom Smith.

Chairman Haney introduced guests, candidates and elected officials.

Senator Leff said her trespassing bill that Governor Napolitano vetoed in the 2005 legislative session would be reintroduced next year. Democrats are putting money into LD-11 to defeat her re-election. Representative Tully said this year's budget is balanced, the Governor is for big government, \$200M remains in the treasury, the rainy day fund is at its statutory limit, and during the last two years personal income taxes and commercial property taxes were cut. Representative Allen reviewed bills he worked on this past session and thanked everyone for electing him to the legislature.

A LD/11 House of Representatives candidate forum was held with Rep. John Allen, Don Hesselbrock, Adam Driggs and Deven Slayton. Each candidate spoke on their credentials, experience and issues. Chairman Haney asked each candidate to respond to questions from the audience.
