

**MEETING MINUTES
REPUBLICAN LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 11
JULY 10, 2007**

Chairman Haney called the July 10th meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Arizona American-Italian Club, 7509 N. 12 St., Phoenix, AZ.

The Invocation was given by Tom Brown. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by James Kraft.

Chairman Haney introduced elected officials and guests. Chairman Haney asked Phil Mason to serve as parliamentarian for this meeting.

Rep. Adam Driggs reported on the approved state budget.

Legislative District 11 and Phoenix Mountain Republican Assembly presented an award to Robert (Rob) Haney, June 16, 2007, for almost single handedly restoring Legislative District 11, the Maricopa County Republican Party, to constitutional, conservative, platform values and goals by his hard work, dedication, loyalty, and leadership since 2003. Presentation was made by First Vice-Chairman John Acer, LD/11, and President Gene Reed, PMRA.

To help with voter registration Tom Husband, 2nd Vice-Chairman, asked PC's to give him zip codes of their areas. He, in turn, will provide post cards with addresses where voters have moved. PC's will then mail the post cards asking if the current resident needs to be registered.

Chairman Haney introduced guest speaker Don Goldwater, who gave an update on illegal alien issues. Payson has removed its sanctuary policy. HB-2779, making it unlawful for Arizona business to knowingly hire illegal aliens, will take effect January 1, 2008, There is still active opposition to HB-2779. The Dream Act is again being discussed.

A quorum was present. The June 12th meeting minutes were approved. The Treasurer's Report is posted on LD/11's website.

Chairman Haney turned the podium over to Mr. Acer to conduct the election of the following resolution: RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF REPRESENTATIVE RUSSELL PEARCE'S REPRESENTATION DURING THE ILLEGAL ALIEN CRISES. The resolution carried with a voice vote. The vote was not unanimous.

Chairman Haney announced he presented the following resolution before the Maricopa County Executive Guidance Committee on July 5th, which passed unanimously: RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CHAIRMAN PULLEN'S HANDLING OF THE CONTENTIOUS .2007 ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION BILL
