FRED KENNETH DURAN, JR. – PC in Oakhurst precinct

Fred Kenneth Duren, Jr., age 63 of Scottsdale, AZ passed away August 20, 2008 in Royal Oak, MI with his family at his side. Fred earned Bachelor degrees at the University of Notre Dame in Civil Engineering and Geology. He achieved his Masters degree in Hydrology at the University of Nevada, Reno. He rose to Vice President at Montgomery-Watson Consulting Engineering before starting his own consulting business, Duren Engineering. He was an avid Notre Dame sports fan attending multiple football games each season. He was also an outdoorsman who spent his childhood days camping, canoeing, and fishing in the Ozarks. He also regularly took his children camping and fishing in Arizona.

In 1999, after all conventional treatments were exhausted, Fred received a terminal diagnosis of Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma. To the disbelief of his doctors, he was cancer-free by 2003. When he passed, Fred was in the process of starting a non-profit organization to help counsel cancer patients using the information he had learned through his successful battle with cancer.

Fred is survived by sons Jeffrey (Kimberlee) and Gregory (Angela) Duren, grandsons Andrew and Matthew Duren, brother Donald (Brenda) Duren. He was the son of Viola and the late Ken Duren. A memorial service will be held Wednesday, August 27, 2008, 7:00 PM at Hansen Desert Hills Mortuary, 6500 E. Bell Road Scottsdale. The family will receive friends Wednesday 6:00 PM until time of service. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Lazarex Cancer Foundation or MD Anderson Cancer Center.

We at District 11 knew Fred as a very knowledgeable political conservative as he served as a Precinct Committeeman. We knew him as a very supportive friend and assistant at our District meetings. He was also very generous to the conservative political cause. When he won the \$ raffle at the County Republican Lincoln Day Luncheon, he donated his winnings to support the District 11 Republican Club. He will be missed immensely.
